

Legal lectures in Siberia



In March 2017, Lionel Blackman travelled to Siberia to deliver lectures in three cities, Tomsk, Irkutsk and Krasnoyarsk, for members of local Bars and law students.

Each lecture concerned the use of visuals in criminal trials. For student audiences Lionel also provided a fleeting history of the UK constitutional settlement.

All Q and A sessions were well supported by the audiences. Topics included Brexit, UK and the ECHR, acquittal rates of our respective courts, how to deal with clients who wish to deny their admitted guilt, legal education in the UK and studying in British universities and many others.
